

# Plisse Door Screen

## DIY Kit, Domestic



### Keep insects out. Let fresh air in.

A side-mounted retractable pleated screen designed for domestic doorways. The pleated mesh pulls smoothly across the opening when needed and retracts neatly when not in use, helping to keep insects out while allowing fresh air into your home.

This screen is suitable for reveal fitting only and is supplied as a DIY kit. If your door opens outwards, the screen is fitted on the inside; if your door opens inwards, it is fitted on the outside.

### Why Choose This Screen?

The pleated door screen is a practical option for everyday home use. It features a magnetic closing bar, white powder-coated aluminium profiles, black pleated mesh and a low-profile 7mm bottom rail for easier access.

For wider double doors, two kits can be fitted side by side to cover openings up to 2000mm wide.

### Before You Order

- Please check that your door is suitable for a reveal-fit screen and that there is enough space for the frame and tracks. This product is supplied as a DIY kit and will need to be cut and assembled on site.
- During assembly, each kit can only be reduced by a set amount, so please choose the kit size carefully before ordering.

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## Measuring Instructions for Reveal Fit

Measure the width and height of the door aperture in three places and use the smallest measurement for each.

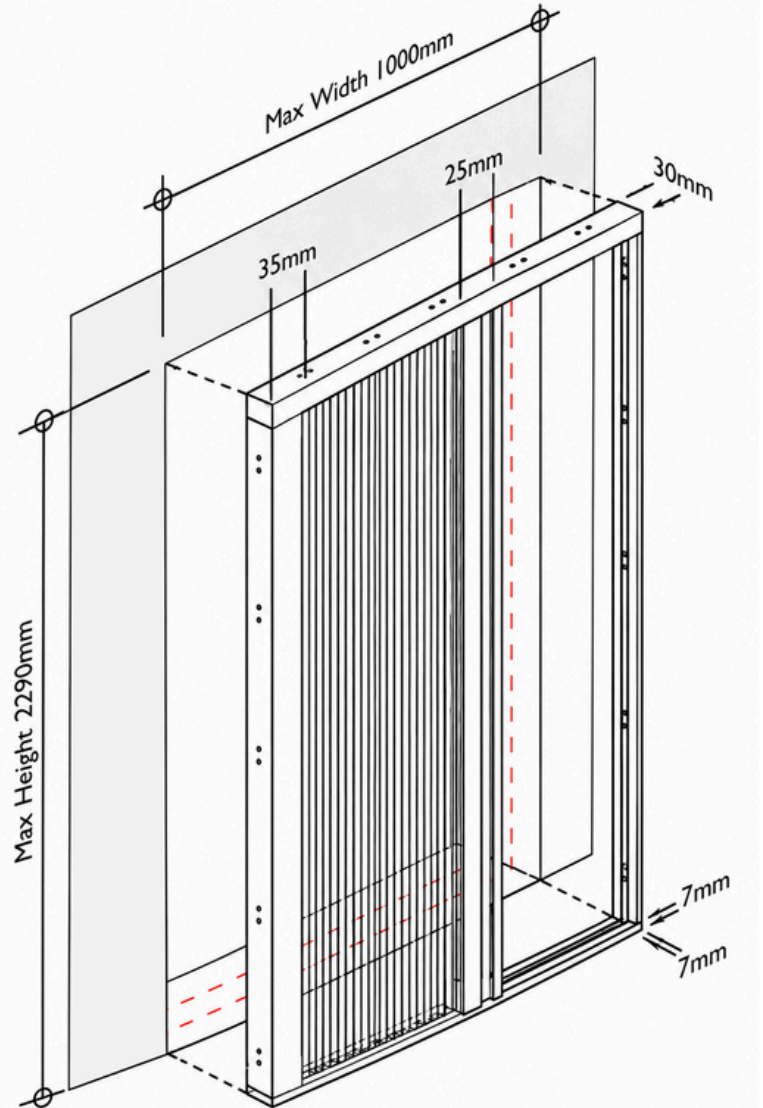
The selected kit size must be larger than your aperture size but within the allowable reduction range.

**Width** = smallest aperture width

**Height** = smallest aperture height

### Important:

- 1990mm kit can only be reduced by 100mm to 1890mm
- 2090mm kit can only be reduced by 100mm to 1990mm
- 2290mm kit can only be reduced by 200mm to 2090mm



### Important Notes

- Always measure in millimetres (mm) and provide sizes as width × height
- Include any bevelled edges in your measurements
- Please measure carefully, as DIY kits cannot be returned once cut or assembled
- The 1990mm and 2090mm kits can be reduced by up to 100mm during assembly
- The 2290mm kit can be reduced by up to 200mm during assembly
- Double check your measurements before ordering
- Two kits can be fitted side by side for wider door openings up to 2000mm wide
